Description

World War II tunnels excavated as part of the Riese project (one of the largest unfinished Third Reich military buildings), a historical route with multimedia effects (light, sounds related to prisoners' work), guided tours of the underground, a tour length of about 60 minutes. Around the tunnels passes the black trail leading to other underground buildings Włodarz and Osówka, distant approx 1 - 1.5 hours.

Accessibility

Entrance

- ❖ There are 3 roads leading to the premises. On each route there are stairs (+18 stairs from the bus parking at the main road, +23 stairs from the lower car park below the main road and +11 steps from the parking to the gallery 3).
- There is a 10 cm high threshold at the entrance door, there are 2 steps 20 cm high at the exit.
- The entrance to the pavilion (the ticket office, shop) is 90 cm wide and opens outwards.
- ❖ The surface in front of the entrance is reinforced (natural stone).
- There are resting areas for sitting at the entrance.

Interior premises

- The communication paths are min. 150 cm wide.
- Most doors and passages are min. 80 cm wide. Two passages with a width of 75 cm (drift no. 1) and one passage with a width of 1 m in a section of several meters (drift no. 2) can be bypassed. The large hall enters the stairs this place can be avoided.
- There is a ramp and sloping staircase to overcome height differences.
- Surface: solid, non-slippery (tiny stones, hardened earth). The surface of the underground paths is wet.
- There are no resting places on the sightseeing route.
- There is sufficient turning space for wheelchair users.
- There are no information panels on the underground tour. Most of the information is provided by the guide.

Accessible toilet

- There is no disabled toilet available.
- There is no baby changing unit available.

Services and equipment

- ❖ A group of over 20 people requires a prior reservation.
- ❖ Wheelchair access: reception desk/ticket office, souvenir shop, gastronomic facilities.
- Guide and registered support dogs are permitted entry.
- Free parking, no reserved parking spaces.
- Audio guides are available for foreign visitors in English, German, French and Czech languages.
- ❖ Induction loops are not installed in the building.
- The printed guide is not available in Polish.
- The touch models of exhibits are not available.
