Description

The historic station offers two routes: Rudy-Stanica 4 km long, Rudy-Paproć-Stodoły 3 km long. Special offer for organized groups, including blacksmith workshops, getting to know the railway works, seasonal events such as the Moraine drowning (welcoming of the spring), St Nicolas Day, baked potato feast and many more. Special rides are also organized, such as riding with ghosts, sleigh rides, fairy-tale reading, etc. You can also ride a draisine, view the station with a guide, organize a campfire or use a blacksmith's workshop.

Accessibility

Entrance

- ❖ The entrance to the historical railway station of the narrow-gauge railway in Rudy is wheelchair accessible.
- ❖ At the entrance to the station building is a 20 cm ramp.
- Entering the train requires some help of the staff or an assistant, but there is a coach with a wheelchair compartment.
- The main entrance door is min. 80 cm wide.
- Wheelchair accessible ticket office.

Interior premises

All communication paths in the building (depot for coaches and locomotives) are min. 150 cm wide.

- The doors and passages are min. 80 cm wide.
- The surface of the communication paths is firm and non-slippery.
- Thresholds on communication paths are not higher than 2 cm.
- There are no resting places for sitting inside. Benches are located outside the station.
- There is sufficient area in the premises to move a person in a wheelchair or a pram.
- Most exhibits can be touched and viewed from close distance.
- The exhibits are positioned so that they are easily visible both from a sitting or standing position.

Exterior premises

- The outdoor areas are wheelchair accessible.
- ❖ The entrance to the outdoor area is min. 80 cm wide.
- The platform and the entrance area are paved, in the other part of the site there are paved roads with minor defects.
- ❖ The pathways are min. 150 cm wide.
- Outdoor area profile: Plain to slightly undulating terrain (with a slope up to 6%), which does not significantly complicate the movement of people in wheelchairs or prams.
- The information and orientation boards which are in Polish, are located outdoors. They are easy to read and understand.
- There are sitting areas for resting outdoors.







Accessible toilet

- Wheelchair accessible toilet is located near the main entrance and is always open.
- Cabin entrance door is min. 80 cm wide and it opens outwards.
- The cabin has dimensions min. 160x160 cm.
- There is sufficient space next to the toilet and there are handrails on both sides of the toilet.
- ❖ A baby changing unit is available in the ladies toilet.



Services and equipment

- ❖ A visit is possible without a prior agreement. For organized groups, prior reservation is required.
- Guide and registered support dogs are permitted entry.
- A playground and children's corner are available in the station area (Activity is provided by an external company, paid for separately).
- Wheelchair access: a souvenir shop, a summer house.
- Gastronomic facilities (barrier access) are operated by an external company and the access is with a barrier due to stairs. To order food staff help is required.
- Reserved parking space not available.
