Description

The nature trail is located in the national nature reserve Rejvíz with the largest peat bog in Moravia, which was founded about 7,000 years ago. It leads along the marked trail from the Rejvíz guest house to Large Moss Lake (area of 1 693 m²). It is about 3 km long and contains several stops with information boards about local specific fauna and flora and also about the of peat bogs. It is a pedestrian path, but you can also take a bike or a pram. In winter, the path's use can be limited. The nature trail is charged with a symbolic amount for the maintenance of the trail. Out of opening hours of the ticket office the trail is freely accessible.

Accessibility

Entrance

- ❖ Access to the trail is without any barrier.
- The entrance is min. 80 cm wide.
- Access to the ticket office is wheelchair accessible. The ticket office is located in the field station of the nature guard at the entrance to the reservation and at one of the stops.

Interior premises

- The trail leads through a natural landscape along a wooden pathway. The surface is uneven and sometimes unpaved. Railings and safety barriers are not on the whole section (along the pathway). The route is narrower than 150 cm.
- The route runs along the flat to slightly undulating terrain (with a longitudinal gradient of up to 6%) and its difficulty is rated as low.
- There are information boards on the route that are easy to read and understand.
- The route is marked with a symbol for nature trails (green bar on a white square).
- Seating areas (benches) can be found at the ticket office and at the observation terrace at the Great Moss Lake. There are no seating areas anywhere else on the route.

Accessible toilet

There is no WC available.

Services and equipment

- On the route there is: souvenir shop (in the ticket office, wheelchair access), a wooden observation platform with a summerhouse (by the lake, wheelchair access).
- ❖ A trail tour is possible without prior reservation.
- Guide or registered assistance dogs are permitted entry.
- Special informative material for children.
- Parking with reserved parking places at the Rejvíz guest house (at the beginning of the nature trail).
