Description

Technical monument in the village Vendryně dating from the early 19th century. Limestone was fired in the furnaces, which was mined in 3 quarries around. Lime was mainly used in local smelters in Ustroń and later in Třinec. The operation of lime kilns was terminated in 1965. Lime kilns are part of the cycling trail "In the Footsteps of Metallurgy", which connects the places connected with the history of iron production in Třinec.

Accessibility

Entrance

The building is located next to the final bus stop and is freely accessible, without barriers.



Exterior premises

- The technical monument consists of two furnaces with a height of about 9 m and 10 m. Both furnaces have 2 holes. The lower hole served for the collection of burnt lime and the top for filling the load.
- The bottom holes are wheelchair accessible for viewing.
- To the loading part leads 15 stone steps (step height 20-25 cm) with railing on one side and wooden boards ramp to the top. The access path copies natural unevenness and terrain differences.
- ❖ In the upper part there is also a preserved loading trolley.
- The building is also visible from the driveway.
- The subject is not street lighted.
- ❖ There is an information board near the building with information about the technical monument. Information is provided in 2 languages − Czech and Polish.

There is a shelter with a table and a bench.

Accessible toilet

There is no toilet available.

Services and equipment

- Guide and registered support dogs are permitted entry.
- Possibility of parking on the turntable bus stop by lime kilns.
- The place is freely accessible, not staffed.
- No services are provided on site and no amenities are available.
