Description

Adršpach Rocks is called the rock city of Adršpach. It is because the towers and rock massifs, which are located on the route, resemble buildings, towers etc. in the forms and sizes. Behind the entrance to the rocks there is a pond with a small island, a great attraction is also Small and Great Waterfall and a rock pond with possibility of boating. The tour is not too long and it is easy to access from the Small Waterfall (about 1 km). To reach the Great Waterfall and the Rock Pond visitors use the stairs, and there are quite a few stairs in the following part. The entire route is 4 km long. Everyone can customize their options. Access to the rocks is chargeable.

Accessibility

Entrance

- Entrance to the area is wheelchair accessible, i.e.. without stairs / thresholds higher than 5 cm and other obstacles. The entrance is min.80 cm wide.
- The entrance to the ticket office is wheelchair accessible.

Exterior premises

- The sightseeing tour leads along a natural unpaved road, with a rather sandy, uneven surface.
 There are tree roots in places.
- The route is min. 150 cm wide.
- The section to the Little Waterfall (approx. 1 km from the entrance) runs flat and is accessible for wheelchair users or prams. Further on there are about 1200 stairs and steep climb continues. This section is not accessible to wheelchair users and prams.
- Information and orientation boards are present on the route and they are easy to read and understand.
- There are seating areas for resting on the route.

Accessible toilet

- There are no toilets in the area. The public toilet is located at the entrance to the rocks in the tourist information centre. One toilet is wheelchair accessible and the key is available on request at the Infocentre.
- The cabin entrance door is min. 80 cm wide and it opens outwards from the cabin.

- ✤ The cabin dimensions are min. 160x160 cm.
- Next to the toilet, there is free space for the wheelchair (width min. 90 cm), which does not interfere with any equipment (waste bin, sink, baby changing unit, etc.).
- There are handrails on both sides of the WC.
- ✤ A baby changing unit available.

Services and equipment

- In the area there is: a souvenir shop (wheelchair accessible).
- ✤ A visit is possible without a prior agreement.
- Guide and registered support dogs are permitted entry.
- There is a car park with reserved parking places.
