The main activity of the museum is the collection and presentation of all Silesian prints created in Polish, German and other languages. You will find here mainly newspapers, leaflets, business (one off) prints, books. The oldest printed material in the museum's collection is the breviary of 1688, the oldest newspaper is a copy of the Schlesische Privilegirte Zeitung from 1813. The library has the largest collection of books and magazines concerning Pszczyna. Of specific interest is the collection of printing machines and bookbinding equipment. Visitors have the opportunity to print a souvenir on a hand typographic machine from the second half of the 19th century.

Accessibility

Entrance


- The entrance is wheelchair accessible.
- The entrance door is min. 80 cm wide and it opens outwards.
- The threshold is max. 2 cm high.
- There is a transverse slope in front of the entrance.



Interior premises

- ✤ All pathways in the building are min. 150 cm wide.
- Doors and passages are min. 80 cm wide.
- The surface of the paths is firm and non-slippery, there are no stairs / thresholds higher than 2 cm in the corridors.
- Visitors can access more than 1 floor of the building. There is no lift in the building.

- In the exhibition rooms there are resting places for sitting and there is sufficient space for movement of persons in a wheelchair and a pram.
- Most exhibits can be touched or viewed from a close distance.
- The exhibits are placed so that they are clearly visible both from sitting or standing position.
- Information panels and exhibit labels are clearly legible both from sitting or standing position.
- The labels of the exhibits and texts on the information panels are easy to read even for people visually impaired (sufficiently large font, simple font, good contrast of text and background).
- Audio-visual information is not interpreted into a sign language or contains subtitles.



Accessible toilet

- Wheelchair accessible toilet is not available.
- ✤ A baby changing unit is not available.

Services and equipment

- Parts with wheelchair access: a reception /ticket office, a cloakroom, a souvenir shop.
- Gastronomic background, conference hall barrier access.
- A visit to the museum is possible without a prior arrangement.
- Guide and registered support dogs are permitted entry.
- Children's corner available.
- Reserved parking spaces available.
- Induction loops are not installed in the object.
