Description

In the museum you can admire a wonderful collection of sea and river specimens caught by shipwrecker Erwin Pasterny, originally from Jaworze, and hear interesting stories about them. In addition, you can admire numerous aquariums with a total volume of 10,000 liters. The museum also displays natural themed documentaries.



Accessibility

Entrance

- The pavement to the entrance to the museum is wheelchair accessible, min. 150 cm wide, firm and level surface (no defects).
- The entrance to the museum is wheelchair accessible.
- The area in front of the entrance is min. 150x150 cm.
- The entrance door is wider than 80 cm and the threshold is less than 2 cm.



Interior premises

- The pathways in the building are min. 120 cm wide.
- The doors and passages are min. 80 cm wide.
- The surface of the pathways is firm and non-slippery.

- The thresholds / stairs on the paths are not more than 2 cm high.
- The museum is a one-storey building.
- There are seating places for resting in the museum.
- There is sufficient area in the premises for moving people in a wheelchair or a pram.
- You cannot touch the exhibits.
- There is possibility to view the exhibits and information panels (texts in Polish) from close distance.
- The exhibits are positioned so that they are well visible to children or short people.
- Information panels and exhibit labels are located at the appropriate height and are easy to read.



Accessible toilet

- There is a wheelchair accessible toilet in the building.
- Cabin entrance door is min. 80 cm wide and it opens outwards.
- The cabin size is min. 160x160 cm.
- Next to the toilet, there is free space for the wheelchair (width min. 90 cm), which does not interfere with any equipment (a waste bin, a washbasin, a baby changing unit, etc.).
- There are handrails on both sides of the toilet.
- ✤ A baby changing unit is not available.



Services and equipment

- Wheelchair access areas: a reception / a ticket office, a cloakroom, a souvenir shop, a projection room (screened film in Polish, no subtitles).
- ✤ A visit is possible without a prior agreement.
- Guided tour of the museum possible. The guide is free, there is no need for a minimum number of tourists.
- Guide and registered support dogs are permitted entry.
- Easy-to-read information material labels are written in large font, simple language, easy to understand. The texts are brief and short.
- Information material written in larger fonts (16 pts or more).
- The museum does not have any touch models of exhibits for the blind.
- Induction loops are not installed in the museum.
- Special programs for children educational films, guided tours for children.
- Reserved parking places about 30 m from the museum.
