Description

A neo-Gothic castle with an adjacent English park, which was the seat of the French Rohan family. The largest collection of French portrait painting in Central Europe is located here. The castle is connected with the stays of composer Antonín Dvořák, who at the castle, among other things also composed there. The basic sightseeing tour offers richly equipped castle interiors. The tour with the guide takes about 60 minutes.

Accessibility

Accessibility and Entrance to the premises

- To enter the castle area from the car park, use a metal gate. The entrance is sufficiently wide and without barriers.
- The entrance to the castle continues through the honorable court a plain, flat surface (coarse sand).
- The ticket office is located in the first passage towards the courtyard on the right. There is barrier access to it (2 stairs)
- There is one step at the entrance to the building (height 8 cm).
- Entrance door is min. 80 cm wide, without a threshold.



Interior premises

- All paths in the building are min. 150 cm wide.
- The doors and passages are min. 80 cm wide.
- The surface of the pathways is firm and non-slippery. Material: tiles, carpet.

- The thresholds / steps are higher than 2 cm on the communication paths.
- The building has 3 above-ground floors accessible to the public, which are connected by a staircase. Lift is not available. In the event of a visit by a person in a wheelchair, an escort is required to take the visitor to the 2nd above-ground floor, where the sightseeing route is barrier-free (the Neo-Gothic Jewel of Rohanů circuit). The sightseeing route on the 1st above-ground floor is barrier-free (Zlatý poklad circuit). The sightseeing route on the 3rd floor is only accessible via a spiral staircase and is not barrier-free (Private apartments of Arthur and Gabriela Rohan).
- There is sufficient handling area for the movement of a person in a wheelchair on the tour routes of the Neo-Gothic Jewel of Rohanů and Zlatý poklad.
- It is not possible to touch the exhibits. Haptic models of exhibits are not available.
- The exhibits are placed in such a way that they are well visible even from the position of a person sitting or a child.
- ❖ As the guided tours take place there are no information panels or exhibit labels.
- There are no resting places for sitting in the exhibition halls.







Exterior premises

- Entrance to the outdoor area is wheelchair accessible, min. 80 cm wide.
- The trails in the area have a solid and flat surface (no major defects). Material: fine crushed gravel and sand, cobblestones.
- The route width is min. 150 cm.
- The outdoor paths are flat to slightly undulating terrain (with a slope of up to 6%) and do not complicate the movement of a person in a wheelchair or access with a pram.

- Information and orientation boards are installed in the area in the Czech language, which are easy to read and understand.
- There are relaxing areas for sitting.







Accessible toilet

- There are 2 wheelchair toilets available for the Eurolock in the building's courtyard and in the castle restaurant.
- ❖ The cabin entrance door is min. 80 cm wide, opening outwards from the cabin.
- ❖ Cabin dimensions are min. 160x160 cm.
- Next to the toilet bowl, there is free space for a wheelchair (wide at least 90 cm), which does not interfere with any equipment (waste bin, washbasin, baby changing unit, etc.).
- There are handrails on both sides of the toilet.
- ❖ A baby changing unit available.











Services and equipment

- In the complex there is: a souvenir shop (barrier access 2 steps), a coffee bar (barrier access 2 steps), a castle restaurant (wheelchair accessible), an orangery (wheelchair accessible).
- A visit to the castle is possible without a prior reservation (in the case of a tour with specific requirements, a reservation is required). Groups must be booked by email.
- Guide and registered support dogs are permitted entry.
- Children's corner and special programs (sightseeing tours) for families with children available a tour with a princess, range and commentary adapted to the children.
- Guided tours are available in Czech, English, German and Russian. Foreign language presentation must be ordered in advance.
- Guided tours are available in Czech. Foreign language texts (English, German, Polish, Russian) are available for a fee.
- There are no induction loops installed in the building.
- Reserved parking places directly in front of the building available.
